Thank you for the prompt notification on the recent flood damage to the United States Postal Service (USPS) facility in Fremont, MO. I recently toured the area to see the damage firsthand. While great strides have been made to return the town of Fremont to normalcy, much work remains.

In an effort to help the residents of Fremont recover from these tragic circumstances, I ask that the USPS facility be reopened as soon as possible and all services that were in place prior to the flood be resumed.
