Dear Attorney General Barr:

I am writing today to request the United States Department of Justice investigate all credible allegations of election fraud that have occurred during the 2020 presidential election. It is the Federal Government's responsibility to ensure the integrity of this election.

It is important to note the alleged incidents of election fraud that have occurred over the past week are not insignificant, and include suspected incidents of vote-buying schemes, voter intimidation, voter impersonation, counting late and/or fake votes, and even the illegal discarding of ballots. These are not unsubstantiated claims as the media would like to suggest. As you know, there are very clear examples of voter impersonation in Nevada and improper counting of absentee ballots in Georgia.

President Trump and the American people are right to demand transparency and accuracy in the election process, and the Federal Government must do its part to ensure our elections are free and fair. The only way to alleviate the American people's concerns and restore faith in our democracy is to conduct a full and thorough investigation into these allegations to hold those responsible accountable.

I respectfully request that your agency do everything in its power to investigate these allegations. Thank you for your service on behalf of the American people.
